Any new Catholics for the Easter Vigil?



Standing Orders, Weekly Envelopes, and Gift Aid Forms

We are suggesting that even those who give by Standing Order sign for and take home a set of envelopes, available from Jackie Ottaway. If a Gift Aid form is completed, anything someone who pays Income Tax gives – whether by Standing Order or in an envelope, however occasional – will be augmented by a tax refund, claimed centrally by the Ordinariate.
